Leadership Definitions

Drum Major: Highest student rank in the marching band. Conducts show, runs small rehearsals, communicates with director(s) and captains, first student here and last one to leave. Ultimately, the success of the band falls on the drum major.

Section Leader: In charge of small amount of students in their section. Communicates with Drum Majors. Makes sure that the students in their squad know their music, drill, and have everything they need to succeed.

Equipment Crew: Helps get equipment to and from field for practice. Helps load instruments and equipment when going to a performance. Gets water during rehearsals. Works with director(s) and drum majors.

Uniform Crew (New): Helps maintain the uniforms. Makes sure that all uniforms are hung up correctly and taken care of. Informs uniform parents of any issues with repairs.

Librarian: Helps organize and copy music - both show music and flip folder music. Will be trained on how to use copy machine in band room.
